








Innovation according to Commission

- Ideas put into practice with success
- Products, production methods, processes or services, opening to new markets and new forms of organization
- More than dissemination of research results
- Results of the creativity and interplay between actors

Implementation under Horizon 2020

- Thematic networks
 - connect Operational Groups around specific themes
 - involve all concerned stakeholders
- Multi-actor projects
 - targeted composition of the partnership
 - relevance of the research for end-users
 - refining during the project (knowledge exchange, cross-fertilisation)

Agroecology & EIP

- •EIP is promising on paper
 - •Focus on mutual learning, sharing of information, multi-actor approach
 - Recognition of diversity of agricultural sector
 - Link with sustainable consumption and supply chain
 - Recognition that farming contributes to public goods
 - Recognition of sufficiency narrative as alternative for productivist agenda
- BUT...also input industry has its shopping list included

Implementation?

- How will EIP be implemented in regions? (budget restrictions!)
- How will EIP be implemented in Horizon 2020 (DG Research less interested in agroecology than DG AGRI)
- Focus Groups: good themes, but which experts will be selected, what will be outcome and impact?

Our demands

- Holistic approach combinig:
 - Food production based on ecosystem services
 - Fair food chains empowering rural areas
 - Responsible food habits
- Multi-actor projects:
 - Diversity of approaches: big AND small projects
 - Practitioners should receive fair recompense for their contributions to research and research policy
 - Preparatory phase to build trust is prerequisite of broad stakeholder participation
- Transparency in the process

- Promote agroecological innovation in the EIP for Agriculture at EU and regional level
- Inform members and support them to form operational groups
- Action Plan for Innovation and Learning
